Call for Surface Transportation Projects

The Central Mississippi Planning and Development District Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) is announcing a "Call for Projects" for consideration of funding for Federal Surface Transportation Block Grant (STBG) Program funds available to eligible applicants.

Available Funds:

The Metropolitan Planning Policy Committee has established priority funding for the following categories:

Pavement Management Project Types	\$11,000,000
Congestion Mitigation Project Types	\$8,000,000
Safety Improvement Project Types	\$8,000,000
Bridge Repair Project Types	\$4,000,000
Small Municipalities (<i>population of 5,000 or less</i>)	\$1,300,000
Total Available Funding	\$32,300,000

Evaluation Criteria & Application Document:

All proposals seeking funding will be evaluated and prioritized according to the MPO's Surface Transportation Project Submittal Guidelines. Blank applications can be obtained by contacting MPO staff or visiting CMPDD's website, www.cmpdd.org.

Submission Instructions:

Submit one (1) original proposal with one (1) copy of all required documentation in a sealed envelope. Each proposal should be typed on letter size paper bound in a three-prong folder or three-ring binder. All proposals must include the following:

- Cover letter from the principal elected official or chief executive
- Complete Application
- An appendix containing all required attachments such as matching funds resolution, project readiness supporting documentation, a project map, and any additional documentation that helps support the project

All proposals must be received by the Central Mississippi Planning and Development District through mail or hand-delivery **by 4:30 P.M., Friday, January 30, 2026**. *All applications received after the deadline will be rejected.*
