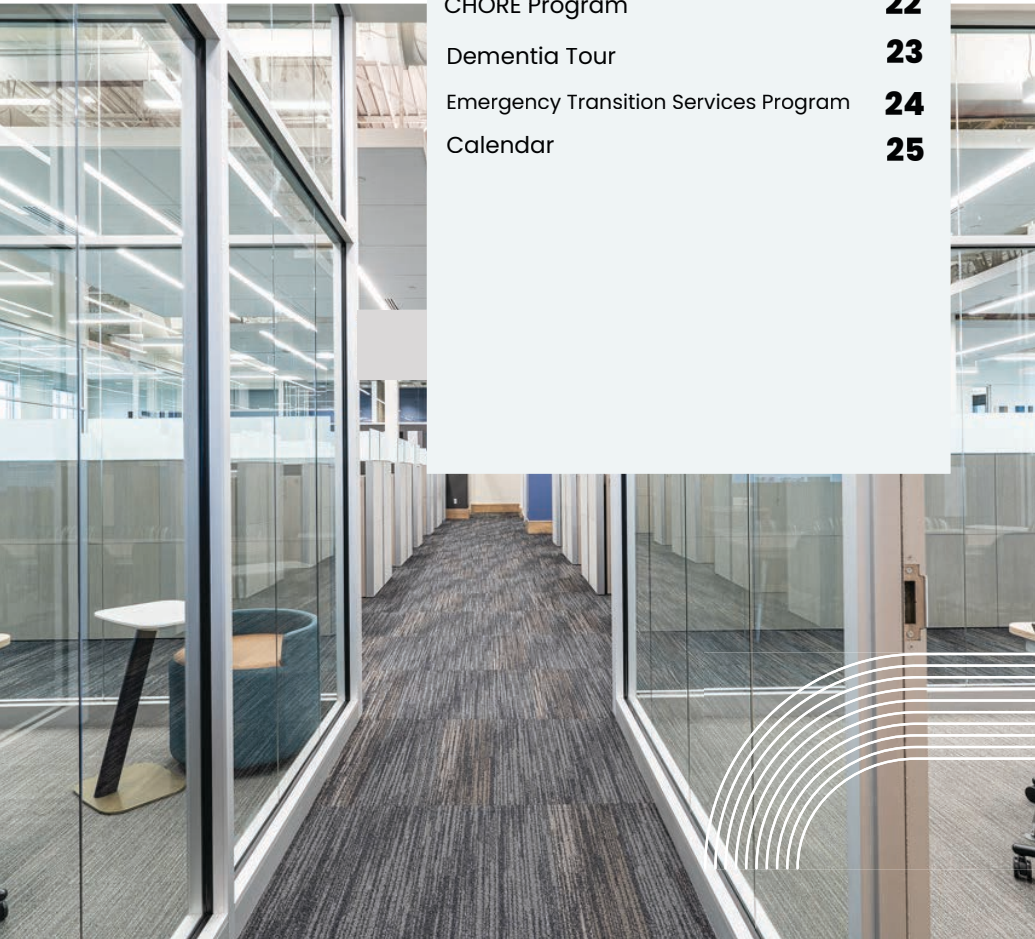
As a designated Area Agency on Aging, CMPDD operates and administers the provisions of the Older Americans Act of 1965. CMPDD's Area Agency on Aging serves the 60 years and older populations in Copiah, Hinds, Madison, Rankin, Simpson, Warren, and Yazoo counties.

CMPDD works in partnership with the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services/Administration on Aging, and the Mississippi Department of Human Services/Division of Aging and Adult Services to provide services to older adults so they will be able to remain in their homes as long as possible, thereby avoiding early placement into a nursing home facility.

Area Agency on Aging SERVICES

Eligibility Requirements for Area Agency on Aging Services

Each individual is screened for services by a qualified assessor utilizing the State's Consumer information form. Clients receive a score which indicates need for certain critical services. All services are classified as either Level I (0-21) or Level II (22 and above). All services require that the individual be 60 years and older.



Aging with Care

Elderly and Disabled Waiver Program

This program allows qualified individuals to remain in a home or community based setting as an alternative to nursing facility care or other institutional care. To qualify for this service, the following factors are required:

- Beneficiaries must be 21 years of age or older;
- Persons qualify by either SSI or 300% of SSI;
- Beneficiaries must score 50 or above on the Medicaid Long Term Care Pre-Admission Screening (PAS) instrument;
- Person must require nursing facility level of care, if assistance is not provided.

Area Agency on Aging SERVICES

Nutrition Program

The Older Adult Nutrition Program provides nutritionally balanced meals to older individuals in a variety of settings including congregate facilities such as senior centers; or by home-delivery to older individuals who are homebound due to illness, disability, or geographic isolation. Services are targeted to those in greatest social and economic need with particular attention to low income individuals, minority individuals, those in rural communities, those with limited English proficiency and those at risk of institutional care. Nutrition Services Programs help older individuals to remain independent and in their communities.

Acadian On Call

Acadian On Call offers medical alert systems nationwide. There's a traditional unit for those confined to the home, or a cellular based unit for those on the go.

National Family Caregiver's Program

The Caregivers Program is a program that is designed for the person that is taking care of someone that is ill/frail. The caregiver can be a close friend, child, sibling, or other family/relative that is taking care of the person that needs to be sought for. We prefer the caregiver to be someone that is either living with the person that is ill/frail or within proximity. Please be advised that this is a federally funded program and we do not pay the caregiver's for taking care of a loved one. The TCARE platform is used as a second assessment to the caregivers' seeking services for their family members. This program gives the opportunity to use person-centered counseling to assess the emotional needs of the caregivers in their roles.

Emergency Transition Support Services

The Emergency Transitions Support (ETS) program provide meals and homemaker services on a temporary basis. The ETS Program aims to meet the immediate needs of nutrition and limited home services during the first 3 weeks following discharge. The program will provide up to 21 home delivered meals and 12 hours of homemaker services to eligible individuals. Referrals can only be made by hospital, nursing homes, and rehab centers.

Long-Term Care Ombudsman Program

The Long-Term Care (LTC) Ombudsman program works to resolve problems related to the health, safety, welfare, and rights of individuals who live in LTC facilities, such as nursing homes, assisted living facilities, and other residential care communities. Ombudsman Programs promote policies and consumer protections to improve long-term services and supports at the facility, local, state, and national levels.

Area Agency on Aging

SERVICES

Emergency Services

This service provides short-term or extended assistance to needy individuals. Emergency services can include medical supplies, food, clothing, or any other identified items.

State Health Insurance Assistance Program (SHIP)

This service is a counseling program designed to provide answers to questions regarding Medicare, Medicaid, medigap insurance, and any other public benefits. SHIP counselors are available for group speaking, one-on-one advice and counseling, and participation as exhibitors in public programs.

Case Management

The Case Management Program is available to the 60 years and older population and is provided at no cost to the client. A client can enter the system at any time through an appropriate referral. Referrals can be made by service providers, hospitals, family members, potential clients, and Aging staff. The main objective of Case Management is continuity of services. Case Management provides the comprehensive assessment by which an individual's needs for services are determined and arranged. Services are organized and coordinated in a way to meet goals and objectives as set forth by the Case Manager and the client.

Dementia Tour

The Virtual Dementia Tour is an evidence-based patented program designed to give people the opportunity to experience what dementia is like through an individualized, experiential tour.

Outreach

A trained worker visits the homes of older adults to make an assessment of the services needed by the individual. They also handle referrals from the general public regarding individuals who need assistance but need help to navigate the many community resources.

Senior Community Service Employment Program

Eligible workers are placed in community service jobs and paid minimum wages while receiving training for unsubsidized jobs. Individuals 55 years and older may apply if their income not exceed 125 percent of the poverty level as established by the U. S. Office of Management and Budget.

LOW INCOME

Transportation

Trained drivers transport older adults to various community resources for the purpose of obtaining needed services or goods. Trips may include doctors' offices, drugstores, senior centers, or other similar locations.

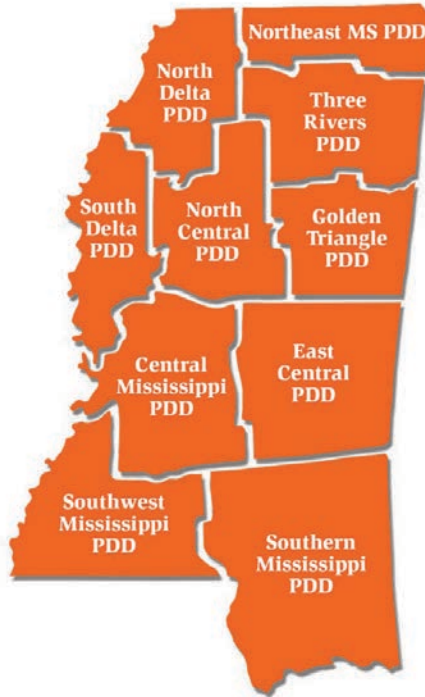

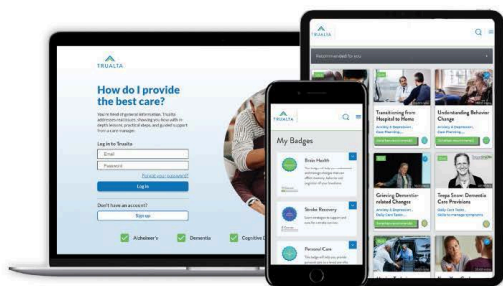

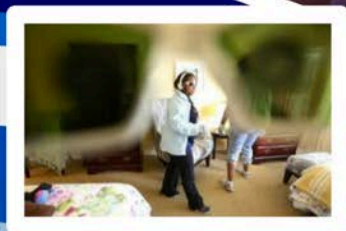

Emergency Transition Services Support Program



Central Mississippi Area Agency on Aging will support those seeking transition from hospital-to-home and nursing home-to-home by establishing an Emergency Transitions Support (ETS) Program to provide meals and homemaker services during the first 3 weeks following discharge.

The program will provide up to 21 home delivered meals and 12 hours of homemaker services to eligible individuals, 60 years of age and older. The services will be provided by state contracted nutrition provider (TRIO) and Help at Home, CMPDD'S homemaker provider. Referrals will only be accepted by participating hospitals/nursing home facilities.
